




# South Africa - Gross domestic product, current prices U.S. dollars rankings

Gross domestic product, current prices U.S. dollars 2014




# South Africa - Gross domestic product per capita, current prices U.S. dollars rankings

Gross domestic product per capita, current prices U.S. dollars 2014




# South Africa - Gross domestic product based on purchasingpower-parity (PPP) per capita GDP Current international dollar rankings

# South Africa - Gross domestic product, constant prices Percent change rankings


■ Gross domestic product, constant prices Percent change 2014




# **South Africa - Total investment Percent of GDP rankings**

■ Total investment Percent of GDP 2014




# South Africa - Gross national savings Percent of GDP rankings

■ Inflation, end of period consumer prices Percent change 2014







Population Persons 2014




# South Africa - Unemployment rate Percent of total labor force rankings

■ Unemployment rate Percent of total labor force 2014






# **South Africa - Current account balance Percent of GDP rankings**

■ Current account balance Percent of GDP 2014






# South Africa - General government revenue Percent of GDP rankings

# South Africa - General government total expenditure Percent of GDP rankings


■ General government total expenditure Percent of GDP 2014






# South Africa - General government gross debt Percent of GDP rankings

General government gross debt Percent of GDP 2014




# **USDZAR:CUR - 12 months performance**
